



## Pupil Premium Expenditure 2018/19

Our core aim is to raise the attainment and progress of Pupil Premium students so that their performance compares favourably with Non-Pupil Premium peers. We aim to address inequalities in education of pupils from low-income families and raise attainment of these pupils. Outstanding teaching and learning is paramount to the progress of pupils from disadvantaged backgrounds and this remains a consistent and relentless focus. In addition to this, targeted intervention and support strategies are deployed in order to:

- Improve levels of attainment and progress
- Close attainment gaps relative to school averages
- Enhance reading, writing, mathematics and communication skills
- Engage and develop learning through a comprehensive extra-curricular provision
- Have a clear focus on all disadvantaged pupils, including those with SEND and more able pupils
- Improve attendance
- Support pupils in becoming aspirational, confident and successful learners.
