Dear Parents and Carers

Well December has finally arrived! All the children came in very excited about the advent calendars and the arrival of the school Elf.... Please ask the children if they have seen evidence that the Elf has been in school.

Rehearsals and singing can be heard throughout the school as we get closer to the productions and celebrations. Learning continues for the next 2 weeks as we have lots of the curriculum to get through, raising expectations and standards.

Free School Meals

Please remember that if your child is in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 they are entitled to Universal Free School Meals, but they are not entitled to any food vouchers or offers that the Government provide. If your child is eligible for Benefit Free School Meals, they'll also qualify for the Holiday Activity and Food Programme (HAF).

Your child may be able to get Benefit Free School Meals if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

The Schools' White Paper, released earlier in the year by Government states that schools should provide a 32.5 hour week for all children, by September 2023. To bring Manorside Academy in line with this, we will be bringing the morning start time forward by 5 minutes, after February half term 2023.

The gates will still open at 8.35am but the bell will ring at 8.45am which means that all children should be in their classroom before the bell at 8.45am.

Inset Day 30th June 2023

The local authority have just released their dates, across Bournemouth Christchurch and Poole, for transition day for the Year 6 pupils to spend a day at their new secondary schools. The date for transition day is 30th June 2023. This is also an Inset day, which means that the school will be closed to all pupils, but our Year 6 pupils will be expected to attend their new school and register there for the day. We will receive further information from the secondary schools nearer the time. Please update your calendars with the new information.

King's Coronation

The date has been set for the extra Bank Holiday so that we can all celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III. On Monday 8th May 2023, the country will come together in honour of the King and celebrate as one country and commonwealth. Originally this would have been the start of the Year 6 National Exams for the end of Key Stage 2, however these have now been delayed by one day. Exams for year 6 pupils will now be held on the Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of that week. Attendance is essential, as always.

Considerate Drivers Please

Please can I ask and remind all parents to look after our community, each other and especially our children when driving and parking around the school.
