Industrial Strike Action

As you may have seen in the news, teachers who are part of the NEU will have the option to strike again on Thursday 27th April 2023 and Tuesday 2nd May 2023. As per the previous strike days, I will endeavour to let you know as early as possible if your child's class will be closed on the days on the strike however, the latest you will be informed is 8:25am on the morning of the strike days. The strike action is not against the school itself, but is part of the wider national dispute between unions and the government over pay and funding for schools. Please also remember that this situation may not be the same for any strike days that follow and we will communicate with you about these days closer to the time. We thank you for your continued understanding around these days. **School Lunches -** All the children in Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and those children that are free school meals and usually order a hot school meal will be ordered a packed lunch. Any children in these groups that are at home because of the strike are welcome to call in to the office and collect a packed lunch. Those children who usually order a hot meal will need to provide a packed lunch from home.
