Word	Definition
<b>Monarch</b>	A leader of a country e.g. King or Queen
<b>Heir</b>	The person next in line to the throne when the current King or Queen dies.
<b>Reign</b>	The period of time when a monarch is in charge / rules.
<b>Reformation</b>	The act of 'changing' something. In this case, the reformation of the church to remove the Pope's control.
<b>Treason</b>	To betray your monarch or country.
<b>Execution</b>	Being put to death.

<p><b><u>Key Facts</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There were six Tudor monarchs who ruled England from 1485 to 1603:</li> <li>• Henry VII ruled from 1485– 1509</li> <li>• Henry VIII ruled from 1509-1547</li> <li>• Edward VI from 1547-1553</li> <li>• Mary I from 1553-1558</li> <li>• Elizabeth 1 from 1558-1603</li> </ul> 	<p><b><u>Key Facts</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• King Henry VIII had 6 wives</li> <li>• King Henry VIII was well-known for his bad treatment of people around him.</li> <li>• Religion was extremely important in Tudor times; everyone had to go to church.</li> <li>• If you didn't attend the same church as the King or Queen, you could be executed!</li> <li>• Henry VIII created the Protestant Church of England so that he could divorce his first wife.</li> <li>• Henry VIII wanted a son and that is one of the reasons why he had so many wives</li> <li>• Catherine of Aragon—divorced</li> <li>• Anne Boleyn—beheaded</li> <li>• Jane Seymour—died</li> <li>• Anne of Cleves— divorced</li> <li>• Catherine Howard—beheaded</li> <li>• Katherine Parr—survived</li> </ul>
