Word	Definition
 weather forecast	A prediction of what the weather will be like in the future.
 symbols	Pictures or signs that help us understand something.
 extreme	Beyond what is normal.
 drought	When there is no rainfall for a long time.
 flooding	When usually dry land is covered with a large amount of water.
 blizzard	A very heavy snowstorm with high winds.
 heatwave	Unusually hot weather over a long period.
 hurricane	A storm with extremely strong winds.
 climate	The usual weather conditions of an area.

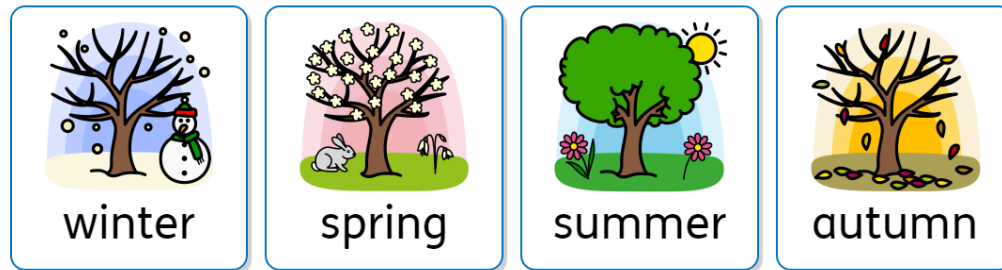

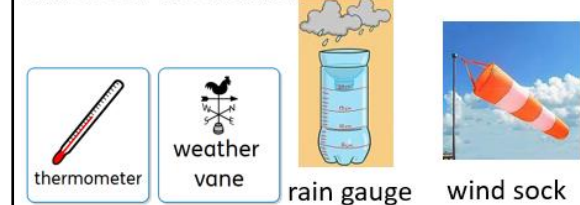
Winter is the coldest season and it usually snows and rains.
