Star Badges

In preparation for the new academic year, we have been busy ordering all of the new resources ready for the children. In order to be the most cost effective alongside reducing waste, we have made the decision to change the Star Badges that are sewn onto the school jumpers each time the children earn 100 stars. Instead of giving the children a badge which states the number of stars that their certificate, all badges will now say '100 Stars'. By making this change, we are reducing the cost of the badges by half which will enable us to spend this money on other areas of the curriculum, allowing us to offer the children a wider range of opportunities during the year.


