Year 1 Learning Journey

Fortnight Commencing: 30th October



English:

We will be focussing on poetry over the next two weeks, learning to identify the features of a poem and an acrostic poem. We will then be putting all of our knowledge together to write our own acrostic poem.

Maths:

We are going to be moving on to adding and subtracting. We will be mastering the relationship between numbers and understanding how quantities relate to one another. We will then be mastering the link from addition to subtraction and using our prior knowledge to help us to answer simple subtraction number sums.

Reading:

During our reading lessons, we will be focusing on sounding and blending words to encourage us with our reading. We will be identifying the difference between real words and nonsense words and using phonics games to support us with this.

Science:

We begin our 'All About the Weather' topic.

The children will be observing changes across the four seasons and observing and describing weather associated with the seasons and how



Foundation Lessons:

Geography: Linking to our 'All about the Weather' topic, we will be answering the key question 'why is the temperature different in different places of the world?'.

Personal, Social, Health Education: What is stereotyping and are these always correct? How do we communicate effectively with adults at school?

Religious Education: What is Christmas? How is Christmas celebrated?

Music: We begin preparations for our Nativity and will learn songs in time to a given beat!
