
Year 2 Learning Journey

Fortnight Commencing: 30th October



English:

To launch our Dinosaur History Topic, we will be learning the story 'Tyrannosaurus Drip' with actions before writing the story ourselves!



Maths:

We are going to be moving on to adding. First, we will add a 1 digit number to a 2 digit number (23 + 4) and will then move on to adding a 2 digit number to a 2 digit number (24+13), teaching the concept of crossing a ten.



Reading:

What is the difference between fiction and non-fiction? What could this book be about from looking at the front cover? The children will be reading to support fluency and will

answer a range of questions based on the text.

Science:

We begin our 'Living things and their habitats' topic.
The children will be classifying living / non-living objects and thinking about what makes a living thing, living using the MRS GREN acronym.



Foundation Lessons:

History: We start our 'Walking With Dinosaurs' topic after Half Term. We will be introducing the following enquiry question to the children: **"Why is Mary Anning a significant person in our local History?"**

We will also be looking at the time when dinosaurs roamed the Earth and plot the Jurassic Period on a timeline.

Personal, Social, Health Education: What is stereotyping and are these always correct? What is the internet and how does it help us?

Religious Education: What is Advent in the Christian calendar? How does this help them prepare for Christmas?

Music: We begin preparations for our Nativity and will learn songs in time to a given beat!
