

Year 4 Learning Journey

Fortnight Commencing:

English:

In week 1 we will be looking at different types of poetry and writing a haiku, cinquain and acrostic poems.

In week 2 we will start our research into the Ancient Greeks and plan our non-chronological reports

Maths:

Week 1– Length, this will cover equivalent lengths (m to cm, mm to cm), kilometres and adding and subtracting lengths.

Week 2— Perimeter, this will cover measuring perimeter, perimeter on a grid, perimeter on a rectangle and perimeter of rectilinear shapes.

Reading:

Our whole class reading book for this term is *Beast of Olympus*. The children will also be looking at extracts from the book '*Alexander the Great*' and '*A Bird, Came Down the Walk*' by Emily Dickinson.

Science:

This term is 'States of Matter' in week 1 and week 2 the children will be classifying solids, liquids and gases and experimenting with making gases visible.

Foundation Lessons:

History: Week 1— We are learning to understand the different lives of men, women and children in Ancient Greek society. Week 2— To understand religious beliefs of the Ancient Greeks

PSHE: Week 1—To begin to understand that families are very varied, in this country and across the world. Week 2—To explore how we can help following a bereavement

Computing: Week 1—internet safety and finding out about someone online and how information can be false. Week 2—Create an informative PowerPoint.
