Fortnight Commencing: 13th November

English:

During our English lessons over the next two weeks, we will be learning how to add suffixes to words, for example the suffix 'ing'. We will be doing this by describing a setting and retelling a story.

Maths:

We are going to be learning about 2D and 3D shapes by verbal naming and matching 3D shapes. We will be sorting them into groups according to simple properties, including type, size and colour.

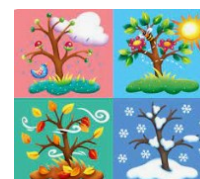


Reading:

During our reading lessons, we will be focusing on sounding and blending words to encourage us with our reading. We will be identifying the difference between real words and nonsense words and using phonics games to support us with this, to prepare us for our phonics screening tests next year.

Science:

We will be continuing our 'All About the Weather' topic. We will be learning to understand that the length changes in different seasons and observing weathers.



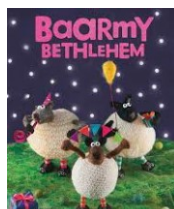
Foundation Lessons:

Geography: Linking to our 'All about the Weather' topic, we will be answering the question "What would it be like to live in a hot country?". We will be learning about the weathers in different countries.

Personal, Social, Health Education: We will be learning about what to do when we get lost and how to communicate effectively and safely with adults outside of school.

Religious Education: What is Eid and how is Eid celebrated?

Music: We begin preparations for our Nativity and will learn songs in time to a given beat!
