Year 1 Learning Journey

Fortnight Commencing: 27th November



English:

During our English lessons over the next few weeks we will be learning how to write a diary. We will be incorporating learning how to spell the days of the week in this and adding the suffix -ed in a sentence.



Maths:

We will be continuing our learning of 2D and 3D shapes and recapping everything that we have learnt so far in Maths this term. This includes, addition, subtraction and shapes.



Reading:

During our reading lessons, we will be focusing on sounding and blending words to encourage us with our reading. We will be identifying the difference between real words and nonsense words and using phonics games to support us with this, to prepare us for our phonics screening tests next year.

Science:

We will be gathering and recording data to answer questions and perform simple tests on how the weather changes on a daily basis. For example, we will be measuring the rain fall over a period of time.



Foundation Lessons:

Geography: Linking to our 'All about the Weather' topic, we will be learning to describe what it would be like to live in a cold climate and applying our knowledge of all weather in different areas.

Personal, Social, Health Education: We will be learning how to make a call to the emergency services. We will also be learning the difference between acceptable and unacceptable physical contact.

Religious Education: Pupils to plan the celebrations of Christmas and Eid in the classroom and to know the similarities and differences.

Music: We will continue our Nativity practice.
