## Year 2 Learning Journey

Fortnight Commencing: 27th November



## **English:**

We continue to focus on writing a non-chronological report about dinosaurs. We have been learning what an exclamation is and how these can be used to share exciting facts about dinosaurs!

#### Maths:

We will be consolidating our learning on subtraction, focusing on the concept of exchanging a ten for ten ones. We will also be moving on to worded problems involving addition and subtraction that require us to understand and solve one and two step problems.

## Reading:

We will be reading the book 'My Shadow' as a whole class to support our understanding of poetry. The children will identify the features of a poem and will be discussing the meaning behind it.



#### Science:

The children have really been enjoying our 'Living Things and Their Habitats' topic. We continue to learn about food chains and will keep reviewing the meaning of following vocabulary: **predator**, **prey**, **producer**, **herbivore**, **omnivore**, **carnivore**. The children will be constructing their own food chains before understanding why animals choose specific habitats to live in.

#### **Foundation Lessons:**

**History:** The children have learnt lots of interesting facts about Mary Anning so far and they are really enjoying this History topic! They will be creating a fact-file about her significant life and will then move on to comparing Lyme Regis in the 1800's to today.

**Personal, Social, Health Education:** The children will be discussing the difference between 'secrets' and 'surprise' before moving on to discussing the PANTS rule (keeping our private parts private) and watching the following video: (2) The Pantosaurus Song!
