

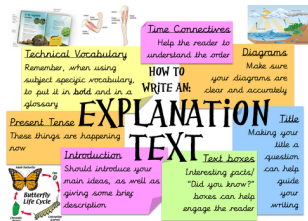
# Year 3 Learning Journey

## Fortnight Commencing: 13/11/23



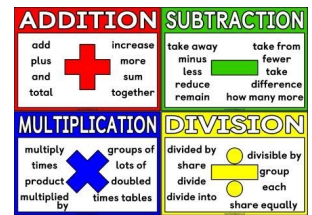
### English:

Over the next two weeks, we will be writing our own explanation text on Stone Age to Iron Age. We will explain the food, houses, clothes and tools that were used during this time.



### Maths:

We will be moving on to our Multiplication and Division unit of work. The children will be looking at equal groups using arrays and multiplying / dividing by 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.



### Reading:

We continue to read the book, 'The Wind in the Willows', focusing on developing the children's fluency and reading aloud. We will also be focusing on a range of retrieval, inference and vocabulary questions to support the children's comprehension.

### Science:

During our 'Plants' topic, the children will be investigating the conditions that plants need to grow by planning and observing the plants over time.

### Foundation Lessons:

History: The children will be researching the Bronze Age, specifically looking at travel, religion and technology during this time.

PSHE: The children will be learning how to help someone if they have been stung or bitten in a First Aid lesson.

The children will also be learning how to be kind online, linking to Internet Safety and our School Values.

Music: To learn Christmas songs as an ensemble and play instruments.

Computing: Learning how to add animation and media to a presentation.

*What was the first thing that happened in the story?*

- Practising times tables and using apps such as TT Rockstars to support with fluency of these.
