English:

We will be looking at the features of a diary and will then plan to write one of our own. We will also be learning to use persuasive language.

Maths:

For the next couple of weeks, year 3 will be looking at sharing and grouping. Dividing by 3, 4 and 8s.

Reading:

In reading, we will be looking at a variety of different ways we can extract information from a text. As a year group we are reading the Minpins book by Roald Dahl.

Science:

In science, year 3 will be investigating how to classify seeds and to observe how plants pollinate. We will be also looking at creating our own plants.
