English:

Teachers will be recapping the grammar objectives taught so far this year: capital letters, full stops, questions, exclamations and different word classes (nouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs).

Reading:

Teachers will be completing Phonics assessments and will be sending copies of these home next week. The teaching next week of Phonics will consist of reviewing the sounds taught so far.

Whole Class Reading lessons will focus on choral and echo reading to increase fluency.

Foundation Lessons:

Year 1: We will be finishing off our 'All About the Weather' topic and will be completing our end of term assessment for this.

Year 2: We will be finishing off our History topic and will reflect back to our enquiry question of, "why was Mary Anning significant?"

We will also be having an Art day where we create our own fossil after sketching and designing our own.

Year 3: We will be finishing our Stone Age to Iron Age topic and will be having an Art day linking to this topic where we will be designing and making a piece of Stone Age jewellery.
