

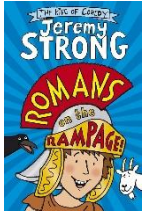
Year 4 Learning Journey
Fortnight Commencing: 15th January

English:

We will start to look at writing a persuasive letter and the features of persuasive writing then create our own persuasive letter linked to our whole class reading book 'Romans on the Rampage'. In our 5th week we will create a non-chronological report for the Romans.

Maths:

We will be continuing our work on multiplication multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100, explore calculations linked to known facts i.e. $2 \times 4 = 8$ $20 \times 4 = 80$ and $20 \times 40 = 800$. Finally, we will look at informal and formal methods of multiplying a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number.



Reading:

Our new whole class reading book will be: Romans on the Rampage by Jeremy Strong.

Science:

We will be working scientifically and we will be investigating ways of cleaning Roman coins and which substance cleans the coins the best.

Foundation Lessons:

In history we will be unpicking how the Roman army helped expand the Roman Empire and discovering how Britain became part of the Roman Empire

In music we will be looking at how to hold a Ukulele correctly and begin to learn some chords.

In PSHE we will be looking at growing up and the changes our bodies go through.
